#### **Notice of Race**

#### 1 RULES

The regatta will be governed by the ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of the USSA and the Sailing Instructions.

#### 2 CLASSES

Optimist dinghies or other classes with at least 3 boats (FJs and V15s).

#### 3 SAFETY

Coast Guard-approved PFDs must be worn and fully secured at all times while afloat, except for brief periods while adding or removing clothing.

## 4 NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located on the bulletin board outside of CYC Seattle.

## 5 CHANGES IN SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Any change to the Sailing Instructions will be announced before the first race in which they will take effect.

#### 6 VENUE

The racing shall take place on Shilshole Bay in front of Golden Gardens. Competitors shall remain on the water during their race period and should bring enough water and sunscreen.

#### 7 SCHEDULE OF RACES

Saturday, August 20th 0945 Registration and Check-In

1030 Skipper's Meeting1100 First Warning Signal

No races will start after 1400

1430 Awards presentation, pizza, soft drinks

7.1 A minimum of 1 race shall constitute a regatta.



#### 8 THE COURSE

8.1 The diagram on page 3 shows the courses

#### 8 MARKS

Marks of the course will be green or pink flags, or orange round buoys.

### 9 THE START / FINISH

- 10.1 Races will be started using Appendix U, the 3 minute Audible-signal starting system.
- 10.2 The starting line shall be restricted.

## 12 SCORING AND AWARDS

The Race Committee may keep track of finishes using the Low-Point Scoring System. However, in the spirit of Milfoil Dodgers Series as a novice racing and learning environment, scores will not be posted. Participation prizes will be awarded to all classes.

#### 13 TIME LIMIT

There is no time limit, but the race committee may ask competitors to sail back to the starting line in order to start the next race. These sailors will be scored according to their positions at the time.

#### 14 PROTESTS

Penalties for protests shall be taken on the water.

a. Competitors shall do a 360 degree turn for hitting a mark or for fouling another boat.

### 13 DISPOSAL OF TRASH

Boats shall not discharge trash into the water.
