Enjoy Port Orchard. Take the Foot Ferry from Port Orchard to Bremerton to explore the Destroyer *Turner Joy*, great parks with fun water features or the Navy Museum if it is open. **Friday July 3-4 – Fireworks at Anchor in Poulsbo – Cruise Leader Cindy Gossett**
