FRIDAYS IN FEBRUARY

Feb 9 - First Time to the Broughtons! *Chris McMuldloch*

Early Summer 2023 cruise to the Broughton Archipelago, BC. 44 days at 6 knots through the San Juans and Gulf Islands, across the Strait of Georgia, up the Sunshine Coast, by Desolation Sound, through the Discovery Islands, and up the fearsome Johnstone Strait into Queen Charlotte Strait on ***Wind Dancer*** a Tartan 3800, with crew: Chris McMuldloch, Jennifer Lathrop, Al Johnson, Jane Johnson, and Mark McKelvy. Feb 16 - Dash to Desolation Sound: *Greg and Mara Barckert*

Every summer in early August, on the morning of the biggest ebb-tide, the Barckert family wakes up before the sun and casts off for a month aboard their Riptide 55' ***Rocket Science***. Two and half days and 180NM later they arrive in Desolation Sound and summer can officially begin. However, we will learn that you don't need a big fast boat to get there quickly. Sometimes everything goes smoothly and other times not so much, yet it is always an amazing time spent messing about in boats. They will share tips for a quick passage and delve into the highs and lows of their experience from summer 2023.
